

## White Course

Black Tees 3,401 yards Blue Tees 3,271 yards White Tees 2,906 yards Red Tees 2,473 yards







Tee box

Approaching the green

Hole #1. Black - 410 yards, Blue – 395 yards, White – 351 yards and Red - 317 yards.

Tip: This hole is a medium length par 4 with a slight dog leg left and a water hazard on your right. A tee shot on the right side of the fairway will give you the best approach to the pear shaped green which is protected by bunkers on the right.

Approaching the green

Hole #2. Black - 205 yards, Blue – 193 yards, White – 152 yards and Red - 142 yards.

Tip: This hole is a medium to long par 3 with water to the right so if you are going to miss – miss to the left.









Approaching the green

Hole #3. Black - 562 yards, Blue – 551 yards, White – 493 yards and Red - 444 yards
Tip: This hole is a short par 5 with water on the left and woods on the right. The fairway is generously wide
but you must find the fairway with your tee shot. For all but you long hitters, your second shot is going to be a
layup. The third shot is over wetland to a long narrow green.

Approaching the green

Hole #4. Black - 152 yards, Blue - 150 yards, White - 131 yards and Red - 106 yards.

Tip: This hole is a short par 3 and depending on the tee and the time of the season; you may be facing a blind shot over water to a oval shaped green.









Approaching the green

Hole #5. Black - 475 yards, Blue – 471 yards, White – 439 yards and Red – 407 yards. Tip: This hole is a short par 5 with water that jets into the fairway about 220-250 yards off the tee box. For your second shot use either a long iron or fairway wood to the green which is protected by bunkers both on the left and front right.

Approaching the green

Hole #6. Black - 400 yards, Blue – 357 yards, White – 302 yards and Red - 237 yards

Tip: This hole is a medium length straight away par 4. Out of bounds both on your left and right but the fairway and rough is large enough to catch most miss hits. Your second shot is to a kidney shaped green with

## Approaching the green

Hole #7. Black - 354 yards, Blue - 338 yards, White - 312 yards and Red - 186 yards.

Tip: This hole is a short par 4 with a slight dog leg right and bunkers guarding the left side of the fairway with water on the right side. Your second shot is to a large oval shaped green with very large bunkers both on the left and right side of the green.

Approaching the green

Hole #8. Black - 385 yards, Blue – 382 yards, White – 332 yards and Red - 279 yards.

Tip: This hole is a medium length par 4. The driving area will get very narrow about 100-120 yards from the green. Your best tee shot would be to lay back at 140 yards. Your second shot is to a large green with bunkers on the left hand side.

## Approaching the green

Hole #9. Black - 458 yards, Blue - 434 yards, White - 394 yards and Red - 355 yards

Tip: This is the number one handicap hole for the White Course. The fairway narrows at 150 yards from the green so either leave your tee shot back at 170 yards or for you daring hitters let it fly. Your second shot will be to a green protected by bunkers to the left and front right.
